



Battle of the Bands Rock-In-Lock-In October 29th, 12am-5am

- ❖ *Battle of the Bands Rock-In Lock-In (BOTB)* is open to any bands ages whose members are ages 13-18 (or a senior in high school).
- ❖ Each band wanting to compete must submit a completed application no later than Friday, October 1st, and they must be able to commit to playing between the hours of 11am-5pm on October 31st if they win.
- ❖ There will only be 10 bands selected to compete, with 2 runner-up bands.
- ❖ Each of the chosen bands must sell at least 20 tickets to other kids starting October.
- ❖ Each band must provide 2 adult chaperones, over the age of 21 that gets in for free.
- ❖ Full backline gear will be provided; bands may bring their own gear at their own risk.
- ❖ The bands will be judged by a panel of hand-selected musicians & music lovers. The judging will be based on, but not limited to, the following four categories:
 1. **Marketing:** ticket pre-sales, online marketing, physical handouts.
 2. **Performance:** Stage presence, audience interaction.
 3. **Musicianship:** Technical ability, precision, band interaction.
 4. **Crowd Participation:** Dancing, cheering, etc.
- ❖ Any band members caught not following any rules at the event will be immediately disqualified.
- ❖ Bands will have an allotted set time, including changeovers. Timeline will be sent out to all bands on Monday October 25th. Bands that take longer than their allotted times will be penalized in their final judging.
- ❖ **GRAND PRIZE!** One winning band will get the following:
 - A major show at Main Event on HALLOWEEN!!
 - The full VIP treatment including private party room for up to 20 guests with appetizers and soft drinks! You all get in for free! (a \$1,000 value)
 - PLUS a 6-hour block of recording time that includes a producer/engineer at one of the School of Rock in-house recording studios! (a \$400 value)

Rock In Lock In

Waiver of Liability, Assumption of Risk, and Indemnity Agreement:

Waiver: In consideration of being permitted to participate in any way in the ROCK IN hereinafter called "The Activity", I, for myself, my heirs, personal representatives or assigns, **do hereby release, waive, discharge, and covenant not to sue** School of Rock and Main Event Entertainment, its officers, employees, and agents from liability **from any and all claims including the negligence of School of Rock and Main Event, its officers, employees and agents**, resulting in personal injury, accidents or illnesses (including death), and property loss arising from, but not limited to, participation in The Activity.

Assumption of Risks: Participation in The Activity carries with it certain inherent risks that cannot be eliminated regardless of the care taken to avoid injuries. The specific risks vary from one activity to another, but the risks range from 1) minor injuries such as scratches, bruises, and sprains 2) major injuries such as eye injury or loss of sight, joint or back injuries, heart attacks, and concussions to 3) catastrophic injuries including paralysis and death.

I have read the previous paragraphs and I know, understand, and appreciate these and other risks that are inherent in The Activity. I hereby **assert that my participation is voluntary and that I knowingly assume all such risks.**

Indemnification and Hold Harmless: I also agree to INDEMNIFY AND HOLD School of Rock and Main Event Entertainment HARMLESS from any and all claims, actions, suits, procedures, costs, expenses, damages and liabilities, including attorney's fees brought as a result of my involvement in The Activity and to reimburse them for any such expenses incurred.

Severability: The undersigned further expressly agrees that the foregoing waiver and assumption of risks agreement is intended to be as broad and inclusive as is permitted by the law of the State of Texas and that if any portion thereof is held invalid, it is agreed that the balance shall, notwithstanding, continue in full legal force and effect.
